Special Note:

1. Sauna rooms are usually built with cork. Due to the special nature of the sauna room, protective coatings (paints, etc.) cannot be applied to the wood used in the sauna room. Therefore, the customized sauna room will be expanded during transporting and storing because its wood material absorbs the air's water. the wood shrinks by releasing moisture into the air (dry air).

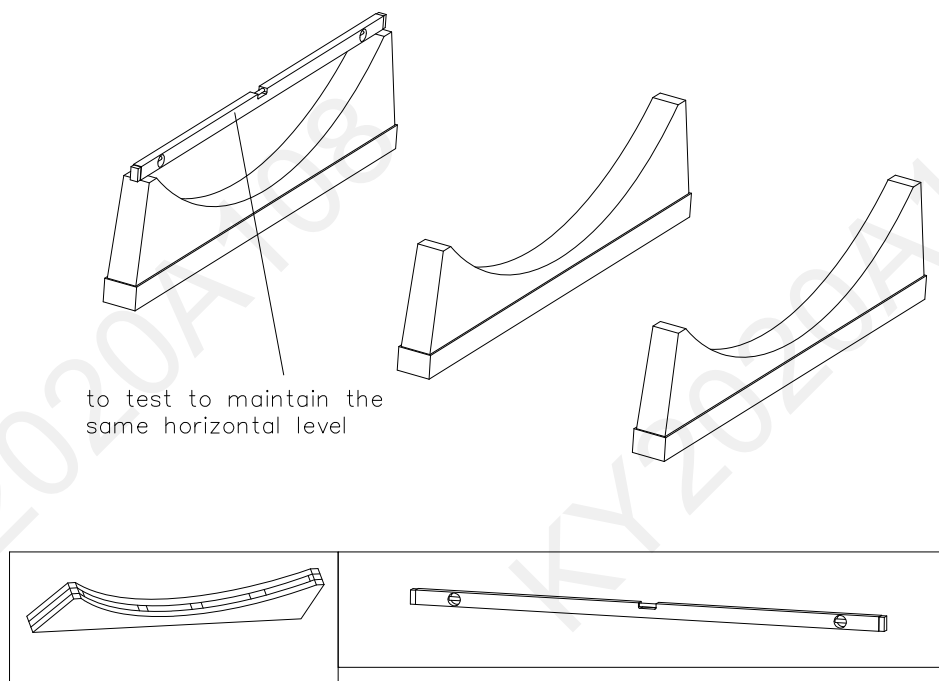
Therefore, it is normal for the horizontal size of the wood, especially the horizontal size of the jigsaw wood to have a certain error with the standard size on the drawing.

2. The sauna room could not be assembled in a rainy day.

3. After the sauna room is installed, it should be covered with rainproof cloth or covered with fiberglass asphalt shingles in time to prevent the wood used for the sauna room from being severely deformed and moldy due to the sun and rain.

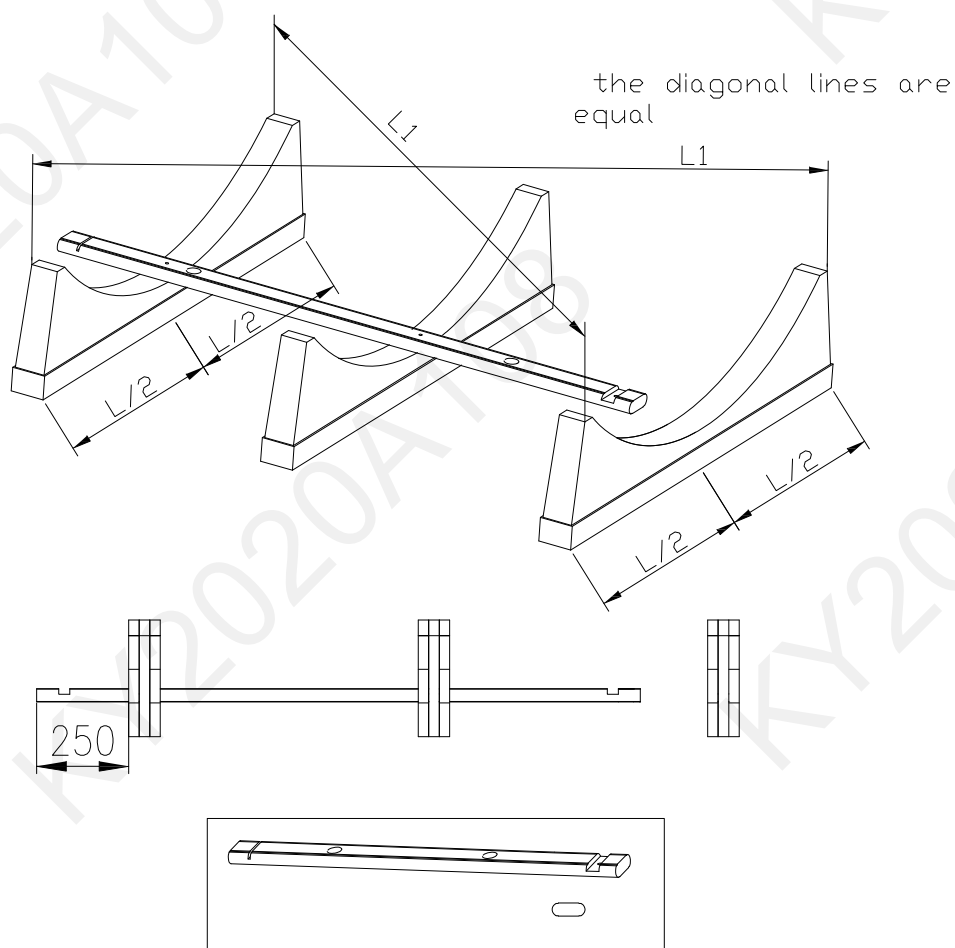

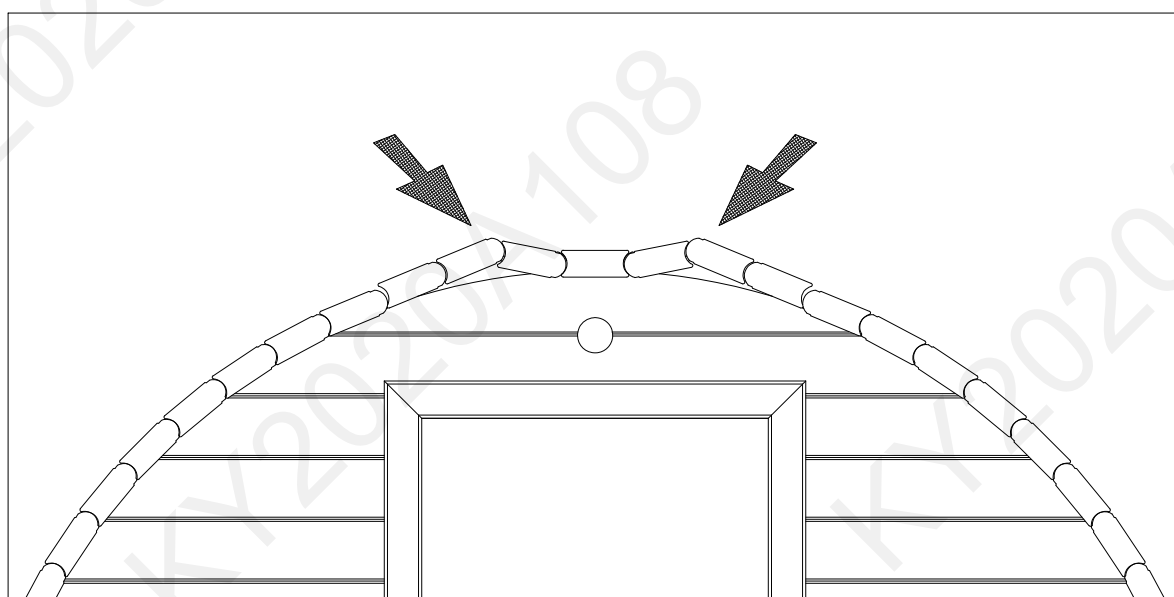


Important Hint!
